Chef's Kitchen and Lounge

With a conceptual proposition, Fernanda Marques's design was one of the highlights of the show Casa Trio, held in São Paulo last October: titled Chef's Kitchen and Lounge, the project translated the architect's very unique and contemporary vision of the São Paulo - based architect, for the room that has become one of the most popular in homes today.

"The importance given to the kitchen in homes today justifies a more conceptual project", explains Fernanda, when commenting on her organic design, unexpected and filled with surprises. "Nowadays we have got tools that can make building more organic and curvy kitchens possible. Rooms in which curves prevail over the traditional straight lines", she says.

With an area of 194 m², the centre of the space is a sculptural structure, which punctuates and defines the project. Throughout its trajectory, the piece performs various functions in a continuous plane: it is a worktop for the chef, a table, a bench and, lastly, a bar, after which it is incorporated into the wooden ceiling.

In order to make the setting authentic the materials used – all certified green and 100% recyclable – were carefully chosen: Corian for the worktop, the wood for the ceiling and the laminate floor. To finish off the setting, a huge green wall planted with aromatic species, acts as a backdrop for home life, as well as providing fresh ingredients for cooking.
