It was in Tumbira, a riverside community on the Rio Negro (AM) that Fernanda Marques and Marcelo Rosenbaum collaborated with the artisan Manoel Garrido in the creation of vases carved on lathe made with sustainably managed wood. 'The reflection of the boats on the Rio Negro River inspire and make us reflect on the existence and permanence of man in the forest' says Marcelo Rosenbaum.

'The color of the wood is the main protagonist of the Tumbira vases collection. Because of it, original and unique, I dared to develop a design that reveres both the indigenous universe and the urban context which I feel inserted. Two faces of the same immense Brazil, which I feel we are just beginning to unravel', says Fernanda Marques.
