In a rather unusual way, the children of the couple of entrepreneurs who own this residence were the ones that guided a significant portion of the interior design project.

In addition to the option for a clean and modern layout, practical and functional solutions permeate the whole 750 square meter area of this house, making it a pleasant place for users of all ages.

Providing profuse natural lighting and total communication between the internal and external areas, a big glass skin covers the whole of one of the facades, totally independent of the concrete structure.

The finishing materials were chosen in accordance with the architectural style of the house and meeting the requirements of comfort and maintenance.

Internally, articulated doors are also accountable for providing the required integration between the ambiances. Finally the distribution of the



blueprint on two pavements allowed the upper floor to be destined to the private areas and the ground floor to the social area and to the leisure and service spaces.
